The KACTE 100 Percent Challenge

All schools with Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs are eligible to participate in the Kentucky Association for Career and Technical Education (KACTE) 100 Percent Challenge. To win,

- * a school/college with a CTE department,
- * a district-wide CTE department, or
- * a locally operated or area technology center,

must attain 100 percent KACTE membership of its professional faculty and CTE administration.

The deadline for submittal of new member applications and a letter requesting recognition for attaining 100 percent KACTE membership of all CTE staff is March 31, 2010. The letter must contain or have an addendum attached listing all names and the corresponding ACTE membership number. If the number is not available, KACTE staff will research and provide. All schools/districts/centers meeting the KACTE 100 Percent Challenge will be recognized with a plaque at the 2010 Statewide Career and Technical Education Summer Program at the Galt House Hotel and Suites, Louisville, KY, July 18-21.

Each qualifying school will receive one complimentary registration to the 2010 Statewide Career and Technical Education Summer Program. The school determines the recipient of the complimentary registration.

One member from the qualifying schools/districts/centers will be chosen randomly to receive one paid registration to attend the ACTE Convention in Las Vegas, Nevada, December 2-4, 2010.
