KACTE AWARDS NOMINATION SHORT FORM

If you or anyone you know might be a candidate for one or more of the awards presented by the Kentucky Association for Career and Technical Education (KACTE) each year at the CTE Summer Program, please take note. Beginning with the 2008 awards, we created a simplified process to encourage more nominations:

1. Go to kacteonline.org after December 1, to review all the awards and the requirements for each.
2. Determine if you have an interest in nominating yourself or another person for any of the awards.
3. Complete the nomination short form, appearing both on the website and sent to each member along with our awards flyer.
4. Return the short nomination form by **January 30, 2010** to:
