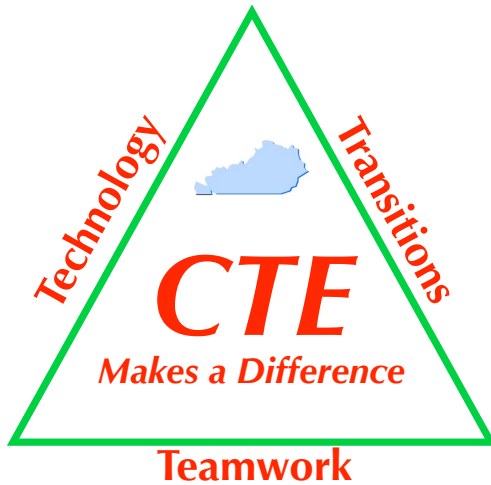

# 2010 Summer Program Keynote Presentations Embody Future Theme

## Murray Banks -- Opening Session Keynote Speaker

A consummate presenter whose messages hit home with educators, Murray Banks is a master storyteller with a knack for finding humor in the most unlikely situations. The 1982 Vermont Teacher of the Year who also was named a 1983 national Outstanding Educator, he uses those award-winning educator skills to create presentations that inspire and challenge his audience to bring adaptability, enthusiasm, and optimism to their work. Addressing teaching style, Murray Banks highlights the importance of body language, story telling, eye contact, facial expressions, and tone of voice; helping the audience understand that motivating students takes enthusiasm, humor, and a "here and now" sense of purpose.



## Theresa Spangler -- Tuesday Keynote Workshop

Theresa Spangler, who for 35 years taught College Preparatory and Technical/Career English to 12th grade students at Georgia's Brunswick High School, believes students learn best with they experience the application of knowledge. She will present the workshop, **The Perfect Storm -- Steering a New Course for Generation Y**, at both morning and afternoon workshops on Tuesday, July 20. Theresa Spangler notes the convergence of three events has created a perfect storm in education. The world has changed. Schools have changed. Students have changed. This entertaining, repeated workshop examines the characteristics and "uniqueness" of Generation Y and offers practical suggestions to prepare students for life after high school. Participants will learn to engage the squatters, the socialites, and the skeptics in interactive learning, and practice a contextual teaching model that targets Gen Y's hypertasking learning style.
